Soccer: **George Eastman** reported that John Miller, WIAA Assistant Director in charge of soccer, researched ejections in soccer and found that most were violent conduct and abusive language. Boys' soccer will be put on probation until they make progress in this area. WIAA would like to see a 60 percent reduction in red cards for this next year. George stressed that the responsibility to reduce the number of red cards is being placed on the schools to change behavior. Officials are still asked to go out and issue red cards when the situations arise. **Dean Corcoran** and **Todd Stordahl** had an opportunity to meet with soccer representatives to discuss compliance with the statewide agreement. Those talks went well and their concerns were discussed.

Spirit: **Cara Heiner** reported Dance/Drill is excited about going to ArbiterSports and has been in contact with their staff about making the program a good fit for their needs.

Wrestling: No Report

Gymnastics: **Dean Ratliff** reported things are going well and he is working with groups to communicate the changes happening throughout the state this year.

Spring State Tournament Report

Todd Stordahl reported there were no issues from the spring tournaments.

WOA Conference Report

Kerri Sanders reported things are ready to go for the conference this weekend. Thanks to all the board members for their help with the conference. **Steve Colby** reported we have 96 people signed up for the golf tournament and there are more sponsors this year. A silent auction has been added and the proceeds will benefit the WOA Scholarship.

Changes to WOA By-Laws – Todd Stordahl presented a proposal to approve recommended changes to the WOA by-laws. **Mike Hellman/George Eastman** moved to approve proposal with recommended changes. **Motion Passed**

Request for Proposal for Uniform/Equipment Vendor – Todd Stordahl presented a proposal for an RFP for uniform vendors. The RFP would be sent out to every association/board and request for them to forward to their vendors. **Bob Berg/Max Howard** moved to authorize the commissioner to issue an RFP and negotiate a successful agreement with vendors. **Motion Passed**

WOA/WIAA Agreement Review Committee – Todd Stordahl presented the final version of the WIAA/WOA Statewide Agreement.
