The selection committee will review all applications and select one or more recipients. The selected scholarship applicant or applicants will be notified by telephone and letter, as well as being invited to be honored at the WOA conference in August in Yakima. All applicants will be notified of the decision no later than June 1st and notification of the scholarship will be submitted to the college or university upon enrollment.

Selection Criteria

- Only completed applications postmarked or emailed by the March 15th deadline will be considered.

- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior and the child or legal ward of a current Certified WOA member.

- The applicant shall have a minimum 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average; transcripts must accompany the application.

- The applicant must have participated in high school extra curricular-activities or athletics sometime during grades 9-12.

- The applicant shall have demonstrated service to their school and/or community and good citizenship. A description of these activities should be included.

- The applicant must attach an essay on the listed topic with their application. This will be judged on content, writing style and mechanics.

- The applicant shall list their particular interest of college study and career goals.

- The applicant must submit at least three letters of recommendation with at least one from a school professional (principal, teacher, coach, etc), one from a community person and one from a current Certified WOA sports official. The person making the recommendation may not be related to the applicant or a member of the WOA Executive Board.
